



## GRANT HELMS WINS "SUPER BOWL OF MASONRY!"

**LAS VEGAS, NV (1/21/26)** – North Carolina mason Grant Helms made history at the SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500® World Championship by winning the 2026 SPEC MIX Bricklayer 500®. The duo of Grant and Keith laid 726 bricks in one hour to claim the title, “World’s Best Bricklayer,” and Grant is now the proud owner of a new 4x4 truck, an Essick Pro12 Mixer, a SpaceKap Diablo, along with additional prizes.

Marking the event’s 24<sup>th</sup> anniversary, SPEC MIX®, hosted the world’s largest and most prestigious masonry competition, the SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500®. This action-packed bricklaying battle took place on Wednesday, January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026, at the World of Concrete expo in Las Vegas, NV.

For sixty-minutes, the Helms duo battled against 28 other masons and tenders from across North America, Great Britain, and Australia to lay as many bricks as they could with as few craftsmanship errors as possible. The champion team working together like a finely tuned machine, proved the competition is a true test of human skill, speed and stamina designed to determine the best craftsman in the masonry industry.

Grant won the JR. Bricklayer 500 event in 2021 and his journey to become this year’s SPEC MIX Bricklayer 500® champion has been incredible. Grant won the Wild Card slot in the competition by laying 774 bricks at the North Carolina regional. The Wild Card winner is chosen by selecting the bricklayer who laid the most brick at a regional event but did not win the competition. Helms will now leave Las Vegas as a bricklaying champion!

The event's second most coveted award, the SPEC MIX TOP CRAFTSMAN®, went to Darian Douthit and mason tender Trapper Reeves who laid 511 bricks. Douthit won the Top Craftsman Award last year with the exact same brick count and he proved again this year that he laid it all on the line to win this award.

Second place was mason Phil Bachetti and mason tender Mike McCarrick laying 723 bricks, only three bricks difference from the championship team!

Third place was Luis Prado, and Francisco Campuzano Arellano with Brazos Masonry out of Waco, TX, 697.

The TOUGHEST TENDER® award went to Mike McCarrick, with Langerap Masonry out of Spartan, NJ. His winning time was 14 minutes and 2 seconds. The TOUGHEST TENDER is a preliminary competition where the tenders are timed as they set up the workstations for the SPEC MIX BRICKLAYER 500®.

Now it's the masonry industry's most celebrated annual event that gains more popularity each year and becomes the top recruiting tool for the next generation of skilled masons.
